Taking stock of COM2024 : Knowledge Sharing as a Driver to Accelerate a Green Transition



With the clock ticking towards 2030, on Wednesday, February 28, the 56th Conference of African Ministers of Finance, Planning & Economic Development (COM2024) opened its doors for a knowledge exchange exercise on accelerating Africa's transition into green economies.
